## Greetings from Sail Sand Point,

Sail Sand Point is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit community boating center whose mission is to *bring the joy and life-enhancing benefits of sailing and small boats to people of all ages, abilities and backgrounds.* Through our scholarship and discount programs we remove barriers to water access, and through our programs we focus on the development of a lifelong passion for sailing, while nurturing self-confidence, leadership, and environmental stewardship.

To raise funds towards these efforts we offer numerous levels of corporate sponsorship each year, for which details are listed on the following pages. Each level equal to or above \$500 starts with a feature advertisement in Sail Sand Point's calendar produced each December and distributed for free to our users, supporters, schools, local businesses and others in the community. All of our recognitions are designed to provide publicity for your organization while signaling your company's alignment with our mission and values and helping to cover our direct program costs.

Examples of what your sponsorships make possible:

- \$5,000 sponsorship equals the cost of 1 week of summer camp scholarships for 12 kids
- \$2,500 sponsorship equals the cost of safety boat maintenance for one full year
- \$1,000 sponsorship equals the cost of 1 six-hour day for 15 participants in a Leeway Program
- \$500 sponsorship equals the cost of 2 professional handheld marine radios with battery chargers
- \$250 sponsorship equals the cost of 6 youth life jackets
